**MANITOBA STANDARDBRED SIRES AND BREEDERS ASSOCIATION
STALLION REGISTRATION ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS**

Only foals of 2013 conceived as a result of matings between January 1, 2012, and December 31, 2012, and sired by registered Manitoba stallions will be eligible for nomination to the MSSBA Sire Stakes to be raced as 2-year-olds in 2015 and 3-year-olds in 2016.

Failure to register the stallion by January 15, 2012, will render all his foals of 2013 ineligible for nomination unless a late registration has been submitted and accepted by the Board of Directors of the MSSBA.

1. **STALLION ELIGIBILITY**: Eligible stallions are those standardbred stallions:
 - a. Owned at least 51% by a resident(s) of Manitoba and standing his entire stud season in Manitoba, or
 - b. Owned by a non-resident(s) of Manitoba but standing his entire stud season in Manitoba and leased at least 51% by a resident(s) of Manitoba (copy of lease must be filed with this registration), or
 - c. Owned jointly by a non-resident(s) of Manitoba together with a resident(s) of Manitoba and standing his entire stud season in Manitoba and leased at least 51% by a resident(s) of Manitoba (copy of lease must be filed with this registration).

If the stallion is not being leased and is not wholly owned by a Manitoba resident(s), the following must be completed and each signature witnessed by a Commissioner of Oaths or Notary Public:

2. **LATE REGISTRATION**: Registration after January 15, 2012. Stallions whose registration application is received by the MSSBA and is postmarked after January 15, 2012 shall be eligible for a late registration to the program for a fee of \$300. NOTE: The MSSBA cannot guarantee the inclusion of the names of late registered stallions on the published stallion lists.
3. **GENERAL CONDITIONS**: a. All applicants for stallion registration must submit with this registration a fee of \$100.00 per stallion or \$300.00, if a late registration, payable to MSSBA. These fees are non-refundable. A photo copy of the stallion's Standardbred Canada Registration Certificate (front and back), or the actual certificate to be photocopied and returned to sender is required for all stallions. b. Stallion owners/lessees who violate the stallion registration conditions shall be dealt with by the Board of Directors of the MSSBA in a manner it considers as just. A list of eligible registered stallions will be made available as soon as possible after January 15.

NOTES AND DEFINITIONS

BLOOD TYPED: All standardbred stallions must be blood typed in accordance with Standardbred Canada blood typing regulations.

REGISTERED STALLION: A stallion registered with the MSSBA for the MSSBA stakes and incentive programs.

STUD SEASON: For the period from January 1, 2012, to December 31, 2012, a stallion's stud season shall be defined as having started the day he bred his first mare and shall have ended the day he bred his last mare.

BRED/BREEDING: The mating of standard stallions to standard or non-standard mares either naturally or artificially, regardless of whether or not a foal results from such mating.

LEASES: When a stallion is leased to a Manitoba resident(s), leases are to be signed before a Commissioner of Oaths or Notary Public, and registered with SC.

RELOCATIONS: MSSBA must be advised within 30 days of relocation if any stallion registered with the MSSBA relocates.

SALES/CLAIMS: A stallion registered with the MSSBA may be sold or claimed during the stud season but the MSSBA must be advised within 30 days of the sale or claim.
