

CRITERIA FOR OWNER-BREEDING INCENTIVE PROGRAM
2011 MGWHRC

To be eligible to the Incentive Program on the MGWHRC, a horse must:

1. be **MANITOBA SIRE** – sired by a stallion that:
 - a. was paid up and registered with the MSSBA for the respective breeding year, and
 - b. stood its entire breeding season in Manitoba for that particular year, and

2. be **MANITOBA BRED** – the breeder (owner or lessee of the dam at the time she was served) was a Manitoba resident, and

3. On the MGWHRC, a horse must:
 - a. finish **1st – 5th** in any pari-mutuel race or non-betting MSSBA stake race and
 - b. be a **2, 3, or 4-year-old**.

Two categories of incentive awards are available: awards to owners and awards to breeders.

DISTRIBUTION

OWNER AWARDS: calculations for work sheets are based on a 20% supplement to a maximum of \$300 being added to the purse on the MGWHRC. The purse supplement will be distributed in accordance to the order of finish e.g. 50% to the owner of the race winner, 25% to the owner of the horse finishing second, 12% for third, 8% for fourth and 5% for fifth.

BREEDER AWARDS: calculations for worksheets are based on the same distribution as owner awards.

PAYMENT OF AWARDS

Owner and breeder awards will be paid following the end of the race meet. The amount paid to owners and breeders will depend on the total amount of incentive monies allocated to each award category. There is approximately \$25,000 allocated for owner awards and approximately \$15,000 for breeder awards. Any adjustment in the purse supplement percentage to owners and breeders will be noted on the final tabulation.

Incentive payments will be made by MSSBA to owners and breeders with no deduction made for trainers and drivers. Purse supplements will not be included in the horses' earnings. In the circumstance of any question as to the eligibility of a particular race for incentive payments, the final decision will be made at the discretion of the Board of MSSBA.
